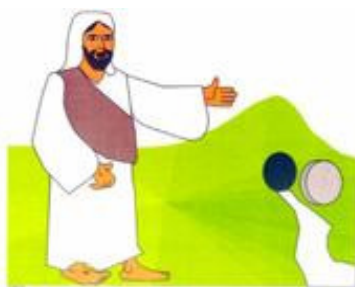

Moses saw a burning bush and looked a little closer.

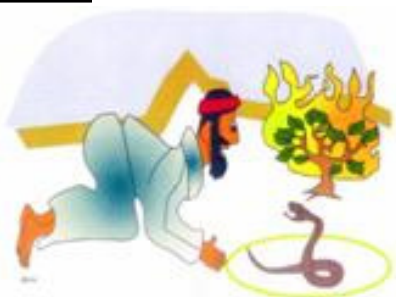
God called to Moses from the bush (*from the bush, from the bush*).
