#### 10 Simple Bible Questions:

- 1. What happened to the Dinosaurs? They died. They were called dragons in the Bible. See Job 40:15-41:34, Psalm 104:26, Deuteronomy 32:33, Micah 1:8, Isaiah 27:1, 51:9... (Note: the largest animal ever to live is still around--the blue whale.)
- 2. What about continental drift? There may have been one level continent originally. Genesis 10:25 says that in Peleg's day ("peleg" means earthquake) the earth was divided.
- 3. What about the Ice Age? We're probably still in it as a result of the Flood. If it was gradual, why do we find "snap freezing?"
- 4. Why are there poisonous plants & creatures? *Death, suffering, pain.... result from disobedience to God. Genesis 3:11-19.*A restoration of creation is mentioned in Romans 8:18-23.
- 5. Why are there 3 major "races?" There's really one race--mankind. The earth was repopulated by Noah's 3 sons. See Genesis 10:1.
- 6. Genesis 1:10-18 says the earth & plants were created before the sun. How did the plants live? This is not a problem if you believe the days were 24 hour days. But, sunlight is not the first or the last source of light, according to Revelation 22:5
- 7. How can starlight that is light-years away reach us if it is a young earth? A general relativity-based model implies gravitational time-dialation. See Isaiah 40:22.
- 8. How did all the animals fit on the Ark? The Ark was about 450' long, 45' high and 75' wide, (comparable to the Titanic) easily able to carry the necessary 16,000 or so animals plus food.
- 9. Genesis 5 records people living to be over 900 years old. How could that be? There may have been a pre-diluvian atmospheric ultraviolet filter, see Genesis 1:7 & 2:6. Post-flood conditions also may have contributed to genetic code degeneration.
- 10. Where did Cain get his wife? His family (Genesis 5:4). Before the Mosaic Law, close relatives intermarried (Genesis 20:12) since there would have been fewer genetic mutations at that time.

K-Ar dating by this method 100 year old lava was dated (potassium argon) at 3,000,000,000 years old 1

at 3,000,000,000 years old volcanic rocks are known to contain excess Ar<sup>2</sup>

U-Th-Pb dating Pb has demonstrated to be affected by weathering<sup>3</sup> Stratigraphic Glacier National Park layers are upside down<sup>4</sup>

<sup>14</sup>C, or radiocarbon, dating is not used to date specimens thought to be millions of years old--only young specimens

### **More Major Problems:**

# 1) ALL of these dating methods ASSUME that there has NEVER been a GLOBAL flood.

(138 civilizations have a global flood in their folklore)<sup>5</sup>
There would have been a much higher rate of radioisotope decay and an imbalance of carbon immediately following a global flood This realization is spawning new research in: radiohalos, fission tracks, nuclear decay theory, isochron discordance and helium diffusion.

# 2) Some scientific evidence that fits the model of a much younger earth with a global flood:<sup>6</sup>

- a) oceans gain 450 million tons of sodium per year
- b) earth's magnetic field decreases by a factor of 2.7 each 1,000 years
- radiohalos indicate the Jurassic, Triassic, and Eocene formations in Colorado were deposited within months of each other
- d) there are numerous out-of-sequence fossils
- e) continents are eroding too quickly
- f) not enough helium is in the earth's atmosphere, too much helium is in hot rocks
- g) multi-layered fossils straddle too many strata
- h) rapid deposition of fine-grained sedimentation observed after Mt. St. Helens erupted in 1980<sup>7</sup>
- i) red blood cells have been found in dinosaur bone, (DNA doesn't last longer than thousands of years)<sup>8</sup>
- 3) When dating methods yield conflicting results, dates are selected that fit an 'old earth' model.



Micro-"Evolution" (wolves to dogs)

Natural Selection (the variation which is observable among all living species) is being referred to as "Micro-Evolution."

This requires **NO NEW GENETIC** information.

Macro-Evolution (cows to whales)
The Theory of Evolution, proposed by Charles


### **Major Problems:**

2) The probability of life originating by chance in a primeval soup is 1 chance in 10<sup>4,478,296</sup> or (statistically speaking) impossible.<sup>11</sup>

#### Examples used: Lesser-known facts:

#### Ape-Men?

Neanderthal extinct tribes of humans with larger brains 14
Piltdown ape jaw, teeth filed to look human 15
Nebraska made from 1 tooth, later found to be pig
Peking none remain, human fossils found at same site 16
Lucy human fossils found lower down in strata 17

#### Fish-Amphibians?

Coelacanth not extinct, "feet" are really just fins<sup>18</sup>
Rhipidistia (swim bladder"lungs")some modern true fish have lungs<sup>19</sup>

#### Cow-Whales?

Ambulocetus fragments found **above** true whale fossils<sup>20</sup>
Basilosaurus a fully aquatic whale, not ambulatory<sup>21</sup>
Pakicetus (walking whale?) only the jaw and skull found<sup>22</sup>

Amphibian-Reptile?

Seymouria dated 30 million years younger than true reptiles<sup>23</sup> **Reptile-Bird?** 

Archaeopteryx fully bird (and scales can't become feathers)<sup>24</sup>

Dinosaur-Birds?

Sinosauropteryx lacked embryonic thumb necessary & "feather" traces were only frayed collagen<sup>25</sup>

Archaeoraptor combination of 2 different creatures (fraud)

### **More Major Problems:**

- 1) Mutations cause a loss of genetic information.<sup>26</sup> (Mutations are 99.99% harmful.)
- 2) "Evolutionary transitions" do not exist.<sup>27</sup> (That's why they're called "missing" links.)
- 3) DNA sequencing doesn't fit an evolutionary model. (turtle DNA is much too advanced...)<sup>28</sup>
- 4) Living creatures have great anatomical variety. (the platypus lays egg—like a bird,

but nurses it's young--like a mammal...)

5) Many living creatures share common features.

(bats look like winged rats, but they aren't)
