

More "Torah Codes"

In Old Testament prophecies, the Hebrew word **Yeshua (Jesus)** can be found in the following Messianic passages:
Micah 5:1, starting at the 4th yod, extract every 49th letter;
Psalm 41:7-10, starting at the first yod, extract every other letter;
Zechariah 9:9, starting at the 1st yod, extract every 22nd letter;
Zechariah 11:12, starting with the yod in the word *price* (se'kan), extract every 24th letter;
Isaiah 53:10, starting with the sixth to last yod, extract every 20th letter to spell Yeshua Shemi ("Jesus is my name").
This is just a small sampling of the research done by Yacov Rambsel, available in his book listed below.

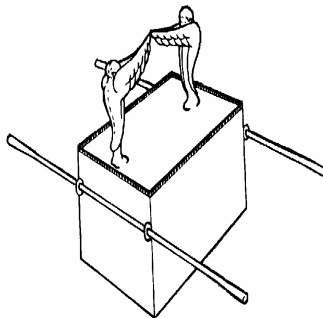

Understanding mathematical codes in the Old and New Covenants
using the Hebrew & Greek Scriptures (the only 2 languages whose alphabets are also their numbers)

Old Testament Math (HEBREW)

In Psalm 119, the Hebrew Alphabet is given (as a title above every 8 verses). There are 22 letters in the Hebrew Alphabet. Each one corresponds to a number (like Roman numerals). Once you master this code, if you have access to a Hebrew Old Testament (or Strong's Exhaustive Concordance) you can compute the numerical value of each word in the Old Testament. *There are 5 letters that have a different appearance and numeric value when they appear at the end of a word. They are called "finals."*

Hebrew Alphabet of 22 letters *(all capitals)*

א (aleph) = 1	י (yod) = 10	ק (koph) = 100

* Not all scholars agree that the finals have different numerical values.

Original 22 Books of the Old Testament:

The Law:

Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy

The Writings:

Joshua, Judges/Ruth, Samuel, Kings, Chronicles, Ezra/Nehemiah, Esther, Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon

The Prophets:

Isaiah, Jeremiah/Lamentations, Ezekiel, Daniel, The Twelve*

Ancient Hebrew scholars believed that the 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet held within them the mysteries of the scriptures and that they corresponded to the 22 sacred writings above.

*The Twelve 'Minor' Prophets: Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi.

Introduction to "Torah Codes"

Hebrew is read from right to left. The Hebrew language of the Old Testament had no vowels. They were added later as dots and dashes under the consonants. The **Torah** (or Law) is the first 5 books of our Bible (we call it the Pentateuch).

In it are remarkable codes found extracting letters at equidistant intervals in the original Hebrew. For instance: In **Genesis 1:1-5** and **Exodus 1:1-7**, find the first "tav" and start counting letters. The 50th letter will be a "vau."

Count another 50 letters to a "resh," another 50 letters & you'll find a "he." This spells "Torah" (תורה).

Numbers 1:1-3 and **Dt. 1:5-8** also have the word "Torah" encoded every 50th Hebrew letter *backwards* (הרות).

The center book Leviticus, which the other 4 books point toward, has the Holy Tetragrammaton (YHVH) encoded every 8 letters in **Lev. 1:1**. The Torah from beginning to end points to YHVH (God). Leviticus 1:1 *start here* ↓

וִטְרָקָא אֵל מִשְׁחָ וַיְדַבֵּר יְהוָה אֵלָיו מֵאֵל מִיְעַד לֵאמֹר

This is an example of a Torah Code:

Proverbs 30: 4 (in English)

"...WHO made rise all the ends of the earth?

What is His Name and WHAT IS HIS SON'S NAME?

Surely you know.

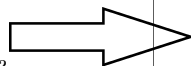
Every Word of God is tested.

A shield is He to seekers of refuge in Him.

Do not add to His Words!"

What is the Name of God's Son?

The answer is encoded in this verse in 22 letter intervals.



Count every 22nd letter, remembering that Hebrew is read right to left (*backwards from English*). Start with the 1st "yod"

Proverbs 30:4 (in Hebrew)

מִי הַקִּים כָּל אַפְסֵי אֶרֶץ

(יְשׁוּעָה) (English translation: Jesus or Yeshua)

New Testament Math (GREEK)

The Greek Alphabet is the only other known language to be alpha-numeric (the letters are used to make numbers). There were 26 letters in the Greek Alphabet. Unlike Hebrew, there are capital **and** small letters (both are listed) for each number. Two of these letters are now extinct,* but were used in scripture.

Greek Alphabet of 26 letters

This is the Greek Alphabet as it appears in the New Testament. Practically every Greek word has at least 4 possible spellings. These spellings also have 4 different articles (*English* only uses "a" and "the" for articles).

That means the same word can have many different mathematical values depending upon its context.

Warning: There is an area of divination that uses numbers, called numerology. God never intended for men to use knowledge (of good or evil) to control or manipulate events. That's why no one knows when Jesus will return (Acts 1:7). The idea that your destiny is fixed is of the enemy (his destiny has been fixed). But, like any deception, numerology is based on truth, God does use math.

Unlike Hebrew, Greek is written left to right:

JESUS (Matthew 1:21) Ι η σ ο υ ζ 10 + 8 + 200 + 70 + 400 + 200 = **888**

(σ and ζ are both the letter sigma)

I AM JEHOVAH, I CHANGE NOT יְהוָה הוּא הוֹתֵי שֵׁנִיתִי
(Malachi 3:6) 10 + 400 + 10 + 50 + 300 + 30 + 1 + 10 + 5 + 6 + 5 + 1 + 50 + 10 = **888**

LORD GOD ("Adonai Elohi") אֲדֹנָי אֱלֹהֵי 10 + 5 + 30 + 1 + 10 + 50 + 4 + 1 = **111**

WONDROUS (Job 37:14) פֶּלֵא 1 + 30 + 80 = **111**

Jehovah spoke to Isaiah (48:16b) saying: "...the Lord **God** and His **Spirit** hath sent **Me** (the Redeemer)."

Those who have trouble with the idea of a tri-une God may remember that in the *Shema* it mentions God **3** times.

And He identifies Himself as the God of Abraham (**Father**), the God of Isaac (**Son**), the God of Jacob (Holy **Spirit**).

Note that Jacob had an evil twin, as does the Holy Spirit. The unHoly Spirit, like Esau, is despised because he opposes God's work.

See if you can figure out the numerical value of these Hebrew words:

(Hebrew is written right to left so the ם is a final mem)

***YAH**

There are two Hebrew words that are translated "**Lord**."

Adonai (or Adon) & **YHVH*** (Jehovah, Yehovah or Yahweh--abbreviated as "Yah.") El, Elohe or Elohim are translated "**God**."

*YHVH comes from the Hebrew verb HVH "to be," "am" or "to exist." YHVH is translated as "I AM." People didn't say YHVH out loud for so long--out of reverence--that they forgot how it was said. Jesus knew it, though, & said it out loud--making the Rabbis furious (John 8:58). 'Jesus' is Greek for 'Yeshua.' (Hebrew doesn't have a letter 'J')

the answers are:

Yah = 15, glory = 15;

Jehovah = 26, honor = 26;

Gad = 7; power = 77;

David = 14, hand = 14;

Abraham = 808, compassion = 808
