## The NIV OMITS 64.576 KJV WORDS:

The NIV **totally omits** the last **15 words** of 1st John 5:7, the last **9 words** of 1st John 5:8, the last **13 words** of 1st John 5:13! And, that's just 1st John!

The **NIV OMITS 17** ENTIRE **VERSES** (another 28 are made footnotes): **Example:** Acts 8:37 "And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." Others:Luke 17:36, John 5:4, John 7:53—8:11, Acts 28:29

## The **Old Testament** NIV translation is full of corruptions also. Here's a few:

- (KJV) **Psalm 10:4-5** "The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, will not seek after God: God is not in all his thoughts. <u>His ways are always grievous</u>; thy judgments are far above out of his sight: as for all his enemies, he puffeth at them."
- (NIV) **Psalm 10:4-5** "In his pride the wicked man does not seek him; in all his thoughts there is no room for God. <u>His ways are always prosperous</u>; your laws are rejected by him; he sneers at all his enemies."
  - (KJV) **Isaiah 14:12** "How art thou fallen from heaven, <u>O Lucifer</u>, son of the morning…"
  - (NIV) **Isaiah 14:12** "How you have fallen from heaven, morning star,\* son of the dawn..."
  - \*(KJV) Revelation 22:16 **"I, Jesus,** have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches, "**I AM THE** root and the offspring of David and the bright and **MORNING STAR**."

In Isaiah 14:2, the NIV ascribes the title 'morning star' to Lucifer but in Revelation 22:16 the NIV ascribes 'morning star' to Jesus. (?)
