8 MEN CARRIED GOOD NEWS TO ASIA

Acts 20:4 "And there accompanied him (*Paul*) into Asia—**Sopater** of Berea; and of the Thessalonians, **Aristarchus** and **Secundus**; and **Gaius** of Derbe, and **Timotheus**; and of Asia, **Tychicus** and **Trophimus**."

8 MEN BROUGHT GOOD NEWS TO THE GENTILES

Acts 11:12 "And the Spirit bade me (*Peter*) go with them, nothing doubting. Moreover these 6 brethren accompanied me, and we entered into the man's (*Cornelius's*) house." (*Cornelius had sent for Peter*)

Also, here's one account of supernatural healing at the hands of **Peter** where the person IS actually named:

Acts 9:32-35 "As Peter traveled about the country, he went to visit the Lord's people who lived in Lydda. ³³ There he found a man **named Aeneas**, who was paralyzed and had been

bedridden for **eight years.** ³⁴ "Aeneas," Peter said to him, "<u>Jesus Christ heals you</u>. Get up and roll up your mat." Immediately Aeneas got up. ³⁵ All those who lived in Lydda and Sharon saw him and turned to the Lord."

And, of course, circumcision was on the **8th day** for every newborn boy: Genesis 17:12 "For the generations to come every male among you who is **eight days old** must be circumcised."

(It's an interesting & worthwhile study to find the number **8** in relation to **resurrection & new beginnings**. These are just a few small samplings.)

8 MEN WROTE THE NEW TESTAMENT

Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, James, Paul, Peter, Jude

THE HEBREW WORD FOR EIGHT

In Strong's Concordance #8083, the Hebrew word for **'eight'** is 'shmoneh' or 'shemonah' and is derived from an unused root meaning "to be fat" or "to cover with fat," associated with the idea of **abundance** or **fullness**.



The number eight is also associated with the revelation of Moshiach – the Messiah. This is reflected in the Talmud which states, "the harp of the era of Moshiach will be of **eight** strands."

8 is Enough (for a 'church')

WHY was the early church instructed to '**not forsake the assembling of ourselves together?**' (Hebrews 10:25)

Was it—as is commonly thought—**just** to keep them from backsliding? NO, although that is certainly be one of the by-products.

To understand this admonition, the New Testament word 'church' needs defining. 'Church' in Greek is 'ekklesia'—meaning a **legislative body that has authority to make decisions for the area where they lived.** A lone citizen did not have that authority. The thesis of this brochure is that perhaps **EIGHT souls** of the **same stature, walking in unison,** are needed to legally make declarations for a city or locale to colonize it for God's Kingdom.

The Ark of the Covenant, also called the Ark of Testimony (Exodus 25:22, Revelation 11:19) represented the Presence of God on the earth. **EIGHT men**—named in 1 Chronicles 15:11-12—demonstrated what caused King David to throw off his garments and dance. (2 Sam. 6:14). *In order to carry God's testimony, they HAD TO BE of the same stature and walk in harmony!*

Inside the Ark of Testimony were 3 things (Hebrews 9:3-4): pot of MANNA (representing the **indwelling Jesus**-John 6:35) Aaron's ROD that budded (representing **Holy Spirit power**-Rom. 8:11) 10 COMMANDMENTS (representing **God's authority**-Hebrews 8:10) (God's Power of Attorney-identifying 10 Ruler spirits by function-in order to bind them)



'8' IN THE BIBLE is associated with NEW BEGINNINGS & RESURRECTION

The patriachs Noah & Abraham both experienced new beginnings in the Old Testament: In Noah's flood, only **8 souls** survived to begin anew. (2 Peter 2:5) **Abraham** had **8 sons** (*after* he was 100 years old!) (Genesis 25:2) *although Isaac was called his only begotten* son (Hebrews 11:17)

8 INDIVIDUALS RESURRECTED IN THE BIBLE

 widow's son by Elijah (1 Kings 17:22) (Note: Elijah performed 8 miracles, Elisha 16)
 Shunammite woman's son by Elisha (2 Kings 4:35)
 dead man by touching Elisha's bones (2 Kings 13:21)
 widow's son by Jesus (Luke 7:14)
 Jairus's daughter by Jesus (Matthew 9:25)
 Lazarus by Jesus (John 11:44)
 Tabitha by Peter (Acts 9:42)
 Eutychus by Paul (Acts 20:12)

8 TIMES THE RESURRECTED JESUS APPEARS

1) to Mary Magdalene (Mark 16:9-11, Matt. 28:10, John 20:15) 2) to 2 disciples traveling to Emmaus (Mark 16:12, Luke 24) 3) to 10 disciples in Jerusalem (*no Thomas*) (John 20:19-24) (8 days later): 4) to 11 disciples—(Matt. 28:16-17 John 20:26-29) 5) Peter(Cephas) fishing with 6 disciples (John 21 & 1 Cor. 15:5) 6) to 500 believers (1 Corinthians 15:6) 7) to James (1 Corinthians 15:7) 8) to Paul (1 Corinthians 15:8)

888—Hebrew & Greek are both Alpha-Numeric (their letters ARE numbers)

Note: Theomatics, Equidistant Letter Sequencing (ELS), Torah Codes, Gematria and other Codes are **not** the same—but all bear the same testimony: the Bible **in it's original languages** IS Divinely inspired.

8 NAMED PEOPLE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

Although all believers in Jesus are told to be **filled** with the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 5:18) by **asking** and **receiving** by faith (Luke 11:13) or simply by **receiving** this **GIFT** sovereignly by God (Acts 2:38 & 10:44), but the Holy Scriptures only give the **actual names** of **EIGHT PEOPLE**—besides Jesus Himself (Luke 4:1)—who were **filled** with the Holy Spirit. Here's what those 8 names mean in Hebrew:

'<u>With Prayer to God' - Bezaleel</u> (Exodus 31:3, 35:31)
<u>'Salvation' - Joshua</u> (Deuteronomy 34:9)
<u>'God's Promise' - Elizabeth*</u> (Luke 1:41)
<u>'Remembered by God' - Zacharias</u> (Luke 1:67)
<u>'Hearing Rock' - Simon Peter</u> (Acts 4:8)
(We are told 3 times in Acts—10:5,18,32—that Peter was Simon's surname)
<u>'Crowned' - Steven</u> (Acts 6:3-6 & 7:55)
<u>'Son of Comfort' - Barnabus</u> (Acts 11:22-24)
<u>'Humble/Small' - Paul</u> (Acts 13:9) (Paul gave this name to himself)

*The only other Elizabeth ('El-sheba') in Scripture is the wife of the first High Priest of Israel, Aaron (Exodus 6:23)

8 NEW things God gives

Note: Besides 'God of..." there are many virtues for 'Lord of...' Here are Hebrew words for God used in the Old Testament: Adon or Adonai (KJV translates as 'Lord') (the Father) El/Elohim (KJV translates as 'God') (the Spirit) YHVH/YHWH (KJV translates 'LORD') (the Son)

MORE EIGHTS:

When Jesus spoke to Nicodemus, the word '**born**' is used **8 times**. (John 3:1-8)

When talking to the woman at the well, the word '**water**' is used **8 times**.

(John 4:7-15) Jesus is called 'Redeemer' **8 times** in Scripture.

Jesus arose on the **8th day** (1st day) of the week.
