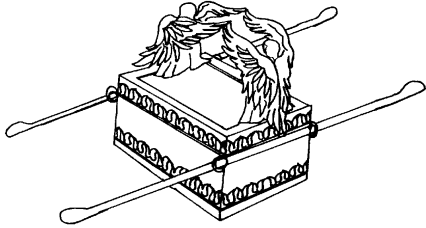


more MYSTERIES of the TABERNACLE of TESTIMONY (*Exodus 38:21*)

MYSTERY OF THE 2 COVENANT GUARDIANS on the ARK



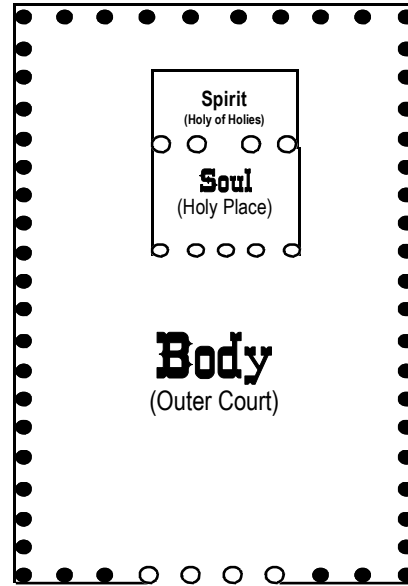
The 2 **Cherubim** on the Ark of the Covenant represent the 2 Anointed Ones (*Zechariah 4:14*) who are Covenant Guardians.

Covenant of Grace: salvation (*Genesis 6:17-18*) by grace (*Ephesians 2:8*) to Noah & all creation sealed with a rainbow—a manifestation of the 7-fold **Holy Spirit of Grace** (*Isaiah 11:2-3, Rev. 5:6*).

Covenant of Peace: an inheritance (*Genesis 15:18*) to Abraham & his seed, sealed with circumcision—dying with **Jesus, Our Peace** (*Ephesians 2:14-17, Micah 5:5*).

Outside the Tabernacle, Grace and Peace are represented by 2 **Silver Trumpets** (*Numbers 10:2-10*) used to call and to send forth the people. (*The Apostle Paul begins every letter he wrote with "Grace & Peace..." and ends every letter he wrote with "Grace..."— sending forth.*)

MYSTERY OF THE TRINITY in the 3 Tabernacle ROOMS



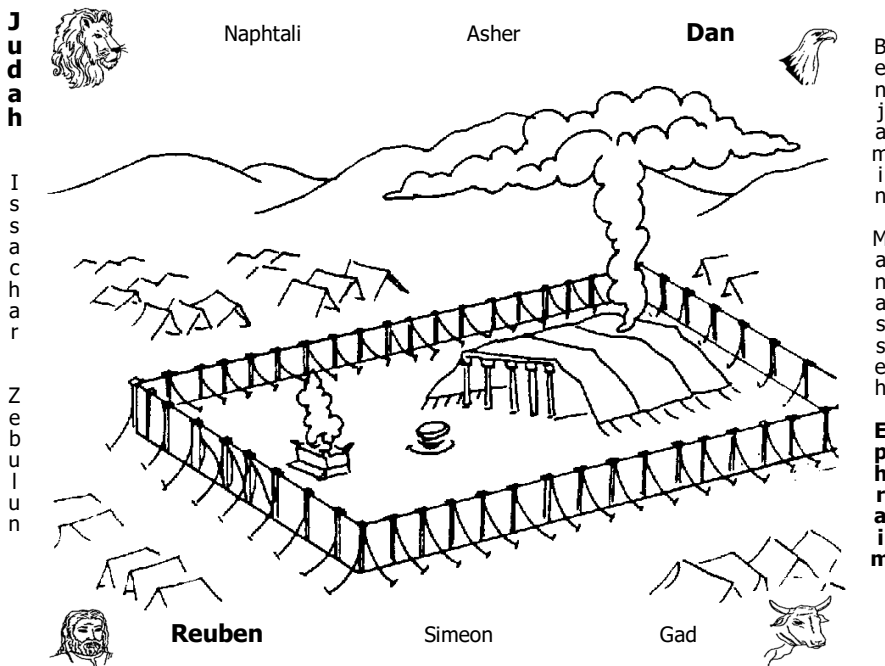
The Tabernacle was a visual aid of how we, like God, are **tri-part** beings.

God revealed His tri-une nature (*Adonai, YHWH & Elohim*) in the 'Shema'—recited by Jews even today: 'Hear O Israel, the LORD our GOD is one GOD.' And, by saying 'I am the God of **ABRAHAM, ISAAC & JACOB.**'

In the New Testament, the title '**LORD JESUS CHRIST**' was also a TRINITY referring to: 'Father, Son & Holy Spirit.'

"And the very God of Peace sanctify you wholly, and I pray God your whole **SPIRIT** and **SOUL** and **BODY** be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."
(*1 Thessalonians 5:23*)

There were **8 people** on the Ark and **8 resurrections** in the Bible (3 in OT, 3 in gospels, 2 in Acts). There are **8 steps** into the Presence of God revealed by the furniture & apparel in the Tabernacle of Moses. Here is the tabernacle surrounded by the 12 tribes of Israel & their 4 emblems (standards)



Mysteries of the TABERNACLE

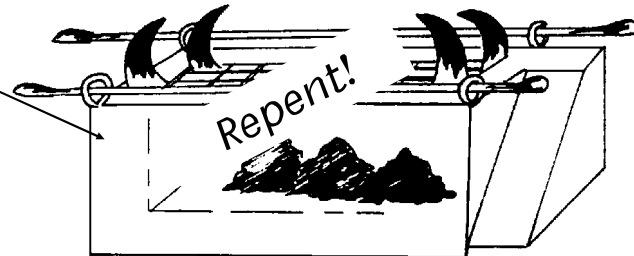
The Tabernacle MYSTERY OF SALVATION

8 steps to draw near to God—visualized with objects: altar, laver, priestly garments, lampstand, table, altar, ark & mercy seat

Tabernacle Entrance

ALTAR

The Bronze Altar represents the place where a person repents & offers their attitudes & actions to God, accepting the death of Jesus as payment for their selfish nature & sins committed.



The Outer Court

LAVER

The Bronze Laver represents the washing (cleansing) done by living 'in Christ'—declared to all by water baptism.



Be baptized!

Garments

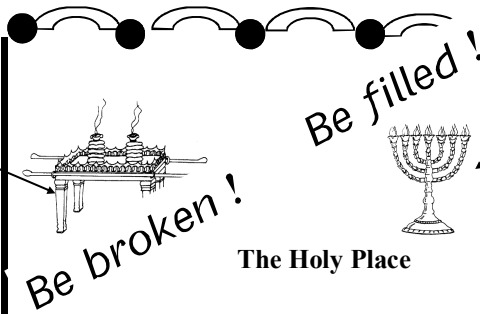
Priests put on special clothing to enter into the Holy Place. Only someone born into the priesthood could go beyond the outer court (be 'born again' & 'clothed' in love, truth....).



Be clothed!

TABLE

The Table of Shewbread with 12 loaves represents the 12 tribes of Israel (God's people) becoming 'bread' to be broken in order to meet the needs of others.



Be filled!

The Holy Place

MENORAH

The Golden Lampstand (Menorah) represents the 7 Spirits of God (Rev. 5:4 & Is. 11:2-3) that fill God's people—so they can be light in a dark world.



Worship!

ALTAR

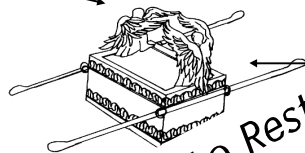
The Golden Altar of Incense represents the prayers & worship of God's people that produce a sweet aroma, pleasing to God.



ARK

The Ark of the Covenant sits on the Mercy Seat, representing what is inside God's people: Manna (Jesus life), Aarons' Rod (Holy Spirit power) & the 10 Commandments (God's Power of Attorney over 10 ruler spirits)

The Holy of Holies



Arise to Rest!

SEAT

The Mercy Seat represents the rest (even in trial) that comes when God's people are in His Presence, covered with Grace & Peace (2 Cherubim).

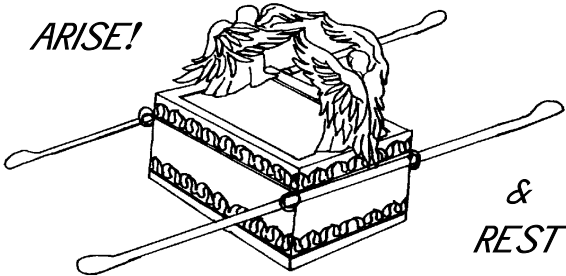
HOLY OF HOLIES-atonement“... resurrection of the dead & eternal judgment.” (Hebrews 6:2)

7) Arise & take dominion— with the Ark of the Covenant (Exodus. 25, 40, Numbers 10:35)

Indwelt by the Heavenly Manna (**Jesus**), Aaron’s rod that budded (**Holy Spirit** resurrection power), a priest can use the **10 Commandments** (God’s Power of Attorney) to **ARISE & BIND** all 10 evil Ruler spirits on their fingers! (these spirits are given various names in Job 5, Psalms 55 & 101, Habbakuk 1-2, Jeremiah 6, Ezekiel 7..., the unholy trinity in: 1 Kings 11, 2 Kings 17, Rev.20:10)

10 Commandments give function—rather than names (Exodus 23:13):
(Bondage/Oppression, Possessiveness, Vanity/Pride, Fear/Hell, the Destroyer, Death, the Harlot, the Thief, the Accuser & Envy).

ARISE!



8) Rest on the MERCY Seat (Exodus 25, Leviticus 16, Numbers 10, 31)

This is the 'SECRET PLACE' of PROTECTION (Psalm 91) where enemies cannot penetrate. The cherubim on the Ark represent

MERCY COVENANTS (renewed generation by generation):
GRACE given to Noah & all creation & sealed with the rainbow & PEACE given to Abraham & his seed & sealed with circumcision.

These 2 Covenants are also represented by **2 Silver Trumpets** (Num.10:2-10) & **2 Anointed Ones** (Zechariah 4:14).

Two blasts of the trumpet were blown to gather the people together & one blast to dismiss them.

In the same way, the apostle Paul **opened** each of his 13 epistles with '**Grace & Peace...**'

& **closed** each epistle with '**Grace...**' (In his last epistles, 1st & 2nd Timothy, he adds 'mercy')

Rabbi Paul 'marked' **God's Name** on believers with the **GRACE & PEACE** Aaronic Blessing of Numbers 6:24-27.

Grace & Peace are present in each major event in Scripture

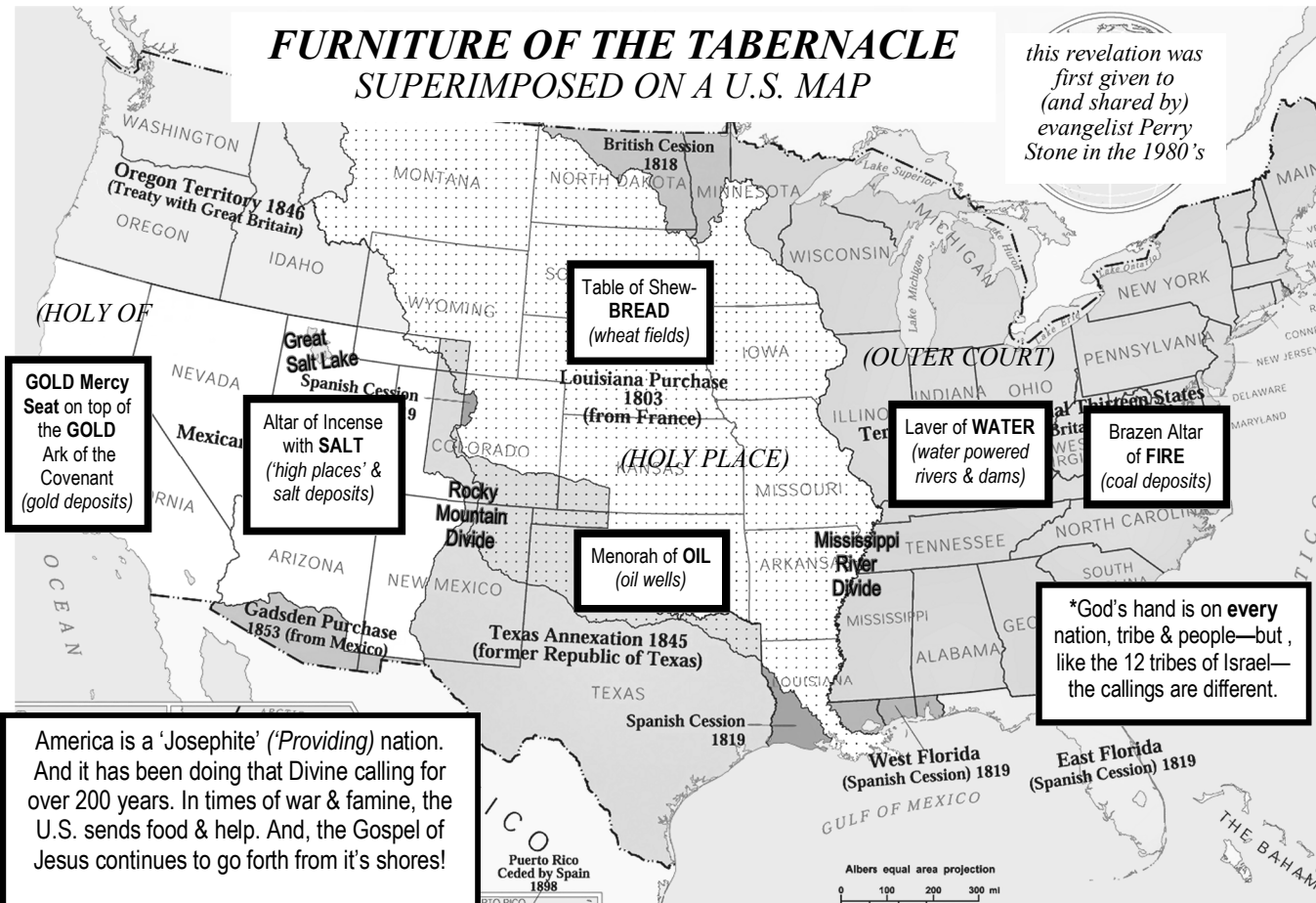
(for instance, at the birth of Christ—Simeon spoke 'Peace' & the name 'Anna' actually means 'Grace.'

Those who abide in God's COVENANTS find that **MERCY** triumphs over judgment.

Resting in Christ comes from eating His Bread (the Word of God) & drinking of His Spirit daily.

positioned to reflect one nation's natural resources

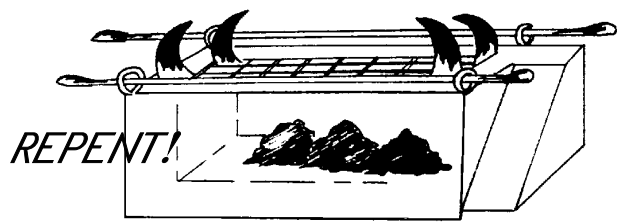
OUTER COURT—purification... repentance...the doctrine of baptisms.” (Hebrews 6:1-2)

1) Repent at the Bronze Altar (Exodus 27 & 38, Leviticus 1-9)

“...PRESENT YOUR BODIES A LIVING SACRIFICE...” (Romans 12:1)

BLOOD offerings—sin & trespass offerings, peace offerings, thanksgiving, vow, freewill, wave, & heave—ALL burnt in fire.

(These represent our **ACTIONS**: confession, restitution, unselfish deeds, testifying, saying ‘thank you,’ lifting arms, dancing to God, paying vows, tithes & offerings—ALL done in self-denial.)



BREAD offerings—unleavened fine flour, frankincense, oil, with salt,

baked in fire done privately (daily AM & PM) and corporately 70 sabbath times a year. (These represent our **ATTITUDES**: faith without bitterness, gratitude, brokenness, prayerful sincerity accompanying our actions—ALL ‘salted’ with the grace of God.)

2) Be Baptized (washed) at the Bronze Laver (Exodus 30, 40)

“...HE SAVED US BY THE WASHING OF REGENERATION...” (Titus 3:5b)

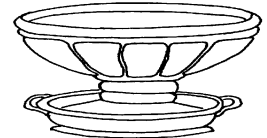
ONE baptism (CLEANSING) for all mankind—the DEATH of Jesus. (Mark 10:38)

You identify with Jesus’s DEATH, BURIAL & RESURRECTION by immersion (baptism) under water—proclaiming that you are dead with Christ (your sin nature drowned) & resurrected with

Him (He now is alive inside you). All 3 baptisms/cleansings (Matthew 3:11, Mark 1:8,

Luke 3:16, John 1:33) are made possible by the **ONE baptism of Christ** (Luke 12:50, Ephesians 4:5).

BE BAPTIZED !



3) Be Clothed with Holy Garments (Exodus 28, 39)

After dying with Christ, saints are BIRTHED into a Holy PRIESTHOOD & given power to FORGIVE

(John 20:23). Putting on (speaking) words of **love, faith & truth**, they may enter the **HOLY PLACE**, & are sprinkled with HOLY OIL—the Holy Spirit (for joy, unity, boldness, correction & strength)

(Exodus 29:7, 30:22-33, Leviticus 8:12) and must keep their head covered with **humility** (Matthew 22:11).

New Testament High Priests **put on more garments by SPEAKING** (applying the blood) words & songs of thanksgiving, deliverance, healing & salvation testimonies, truth, righteousness... & go into the **HOLY OF HOLIES**.

BE CLOTHED



HOLY PLACE—consecration “... laying on of hands...” (Hebrews 6:2)

4) Be Filled at the Golden Lampstand (Ex. 25, 27, 30, Lev. 24, Num 4 & 8)

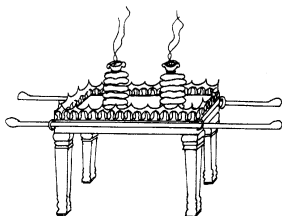
RECEIVE!



In the Holy Place, on the left, is a menorah FILLED with Holy Oil. It represented the 7-fold Holy Spirit (Rev. 4:5 & 5:6): the **Spirit of the Lord, Wisdom & Understanding, Counsel & Strength, Knowledge & Fear of the Lord** (Is. 11:1-2). These are **God’s 7 transmitters & receivers** on the earth—just as your 7 holes in your head: 1 Mouth, 2 Ears, 2 Nostrils & 2 Eyes are your 7 transmitters & receivers. When you ask (Luke 11:13) & are filled with God’s Holy Spirit (Acts 2:4, 10:44, 19:6), the confusion of Babel (Gen. 11:1-9) begins to be reversed—with new languages of men & angels. Spiritual EARS hear, spiritual NOSTRILS breathe life to others & spiritual EYES are opened.

5) Serve (give yourself as broken bread) at the Table of Shewbread (Ex. 25, 35:13 Lev.24)

SERVE!



In the Holy Place, on the right, was a table with 2 rows of 6 loaves each. They represented the 12 Tribes of Israel (Revelation 7) as sustenance. Believers in Jesus are grafted into Israel into a tribe of Israel (Rom. 2:29, 11:19). **Simeon** (‘to hear’) **PROPHETS**; **Levi** (‘cling’) **TEACHERS**;

Judah (‘lifted hands’) **LEADERS**; **Issachar** (‘hired’/‘reward’) **EVANGELISTS**;

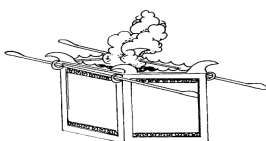
Joseph (‘to add’) **PROVIDERS**; **Benjamin** (‘son of the right hand’) **APOSTLES**;

Reuben (‘see, a son’) **RESTORERS**; **Gad** (‘lucky/troop’) **HEALERS**;

Asher (‘happy’) **SERVANTS**, **Zebulun** (‘to dwell’) **GIVERS**, **Dan** (‘to judge’) **BUILDERS**; & **Naphtali** (‘wrestling’) **SHEPHERDS**. These are 12 entrances to the Holy City (Rev. 21:12)

As our Lord became broken BREAD and poured out WINE, so should His priests humbly allow themselves to be consumed—bringing His life to others.

INTERCEDE!



6) Pray (for others) at the Altar of Incense (Ex. 37:25-29, Lev. 16:12-13, Rev. 5:8, 6:9)

In the center of the Holy Place was an altar where **4 salted spices** were kept burning as a sweet aroma. Salt refers to the **GRACE** of God given to: 1) His **PEOPLE**, offering His

2) PRAISES, invoking His **3) NAME** (which is the **Word of God**—Rev. 19:13) for His

4) GLORY. (Deuteronomy 26:19 & Jeremiah 13:11) Turn every thought into a prayer (thereby practicing the presence of God). Note: **Repentance** is the **foundation** of true worship & intercession—since the fire on this altar **must** originate from the altar of Burnt Offering.
